*We recognise that our activities have an impact on the environment in the use of raw materials, emissions to air and water, waste generation, and interaction with marine life and habitat. We are committed to minimising this impact as far as is reasonably practicable for both offshore and office based activities. We do this by maintaining a programme of continual improvement in environmental performance incorporating suitable measurement and monitoring.*

We strive to:

1. Comply with environmental legislation, regulations and codes of practice relevant to the industry sector in which we operate.
2. Reduce the consumption of natural resources and materials by improving efficiency, including the use of water, energy, fuel and raw materials.
3. Minimise the impact of our operations on the environments in which we operate, including habitat, wildlife, fauna and flora.
4. Reduce emissions by selection of fuel, technology, operating efficiency and optimising business travel.
5. Prevent pollution through release to the environment, and have in place emergency plans to minimise the impact should a release occur.
6. Promote recycling and wherever possible use materials that have been recycled or can be recycled after use.
7. Minimise and segregate waste, ensuring the safe keeping, transportation and subsequent recovery or disposal.
8. Include environmental issues in our training programmes to enable employees to fulfil their responsibilities, and encourage staff to contribute to sound environmental practice.
9. Encourage major suppliers and contractors to develop similar environmental policies and programs.
